

# Awana Servants

Please prayerfully consider serving in the Awana ministry Wednesday evenings plus some additional activities during the year from August to May. Registration begins July 22. We will have in-church training for all staff on August 15, and initial and continuation training for all Awana staff, whether you are new or an Awana veteran, in Jacksonville on August 25. Some of the positions are:

**BCLR Kids Care:** We need two BCLR members to serve in kids care each Wednesday evening during the Awana year, for children un-potty trained three year olds and younger whose parents are serving or participating in one of the Wednesday evening ministries. We would prefer these positions to be full time (same persons) but we can accommodate a part-time rotating schedule.

**Director:** The Director has overall supervision of the Club. Although the Director works with the clubbers, their primary responsibility is recruiting, planning, organizing, coordinating, directing, mentoring, and encouraging the other assigned Leaders in their Club. The Director can also teach the Large Group Time or delegate that task.

**Secretary:** The secretary issues vests/shirts and books, maintains records about clubbers' attendance and achievement, provides information for parents, and is aware of inventory needs for Club Leaders.

**Leader:** A Leader directly works with and mentors an assigned group of 4-6 children. You will listen, explain, and sign off their verses each week and keep in touch with them other than club nights to encourage, mentor, and bond with the clubbers. You will serve as line coach during Game Time. A **Student Leader** is a leader under the age of 19.


**Listener:** The Listener has similar responsibilities as a Leader except they have not completed all the required training to be a Leader or they are only available during club to listen, explain, and sign off clubbers' verses.

**Red River Valley Honors Camp Counselors (June 16-23, 2018):** Serve as a camp counselor for a week with an assigned group of 8-10 campers who have qualified to attend camp by achieving the Awana Excellence Award or as a guest and are going into the 6th grade and above.
