Protecting Your Child's Health

The Bible Church of Little Rock desires to provide a healthy environment for your child. With this goal in mind, we have adopted the following health care practices. Children will be excluded from church activities if any of the following conditions exist:

- Discolored (not clear) nasal discharge
- Fever within the last 24 hours
- Unusual lethargy, irritability, persistent crying, difficulty breathing or other signs of possible severe illness
- Strep throat, until 24 hours after treatment has been initiated, and until the child has been free of fever for 24 hours
- Diarrhea that is not contained by diapers
- Vomiting two or more times in the previous 24 hours unless the vomiting is determined to be due to a noncommunicable condition
- Mouth sores associated with an inability of the child to control his saliva
- Chicken pox, until the sixth day after the onset of rash or sooner only if all lesions have dried and crusted
- Pink eye with white or yellow discharge, often with matted eyelids after sleep and eye pain or redness of the eyelids or skin surrounding the eye, until 24 hours after treatment has been initiated
- Mumps, until nine days after onset of parotid gland swelling
- Scabies, until after treatment has been completed
- Any open skin sore until 24 hours after treatment has been initiated
- Persistent, uncontrollable biting

Unless your child is allergic to disposable diapers or training pants, please let him wear them while he is at church.
